## Three Options for Visiting Professors

- **One Semester Option**

Stay from mid-March to mid-July or from October to Christmas

Teach 8 h per week, i.e. in your own class, in a class with a German professor (team teaching), a seminar

- **Two Semester Option**

Stay from mid-March to mid-February or from October to July

Teach 8 h per week and semester (15 weeks), i.e. in your own class, in a class with a German professor (team teaching), a seminar

- **Half a Month Option**

Stay for two weeks in April, May, June, October, November, or December

Teach 8 h per week in an NGU professor's class

## Terms and Conditions

- Travel costs (economy class) and public transportation are covered
- Free accommodation
- Per diem subsidy according to German tax law during the stay
- Free access to university amenities like library, computer labs, cafeteria, office space and computer of your own (long-term professors)
- Full service package for your stay:
  - Assistance with preparing all the necessary arrangements for travel and accommodation, visa formalities, bank issues, health insurance
  - Introducing you to faculty members and staff in your field
  - Giving you the opportunity to establish contacts with companies in the prosperous economy of our region, which is among the strongest in Europe
  - Making you familiar with our beautiful surroundings - attractive tourist destinations
- Nomination must be approved by a committee consisting of representatives of NGU and of the Educational Foundation of Kreissparkasse Esslingen-Nürtingen for Esslingen County based on a recommendation of the sending institution
