




Campus

Campus buildings in Geislingen:



Email

After enrolling at NGU you will receive a university email address ending in @stud.hfwu.de.

Since email is the official means of communication at the university, you are obliged to use it to stay up to date and to avoid missing out on important information. Engagement

Exam period

NGU always consults the students when making decisions. You can get involved in various committees and actively participate in decision-making! The elections, in which you can secure a place on one of the committees, take place in May every year.

There are two examination periods per year. In the winter semester, the examination period runs from about the end of January to mid-February and in the summer semester from the beginning to the end of July.

Student Council (StuRa):

Exams

The StuRa consists exclusively of students who represent the interests of their fellow students at NGU. Among other things, it administers a part of your semester fee and makes sure that the money is used for meaningful projects and for the benefit of the students. At the end of each semester, you will all have exams coming up. How many and which exams or written tests you take depends entirely on your program and the examinations you have registered for. You can find the exact exam dates in neo: neo.hfwu.de

Faculty Council:

The Faculty Council makes important decisions for that respective faculty, e.g. concerning study and examination regulations, the further development of that faculty or which professors may be teaching courses in future.

Senate:

The Senate is an important supervisory authority of the Rectorate and is involved in deciding the fundamental direction of the university. As a member of the Senate, you can elect the members of the Rectorate, participate in decisions on which degree programs and institutions should be established at NGU in the future, discuss examination regulations and much more. Financing

BaföG:

One of the most important grants available for students habitually resident in Germany is the so-called BAföG (German Federal Training Assistance Act). Each case is decided individually, so it is well worth applying for. Scholarships

A scholarship is financial support which is awarded according to certain criteria and which does not have to be paid back. A scholarship is not only for highly gifted students. Although excellent grades are often a prerequisite for obtaining a scholarship, there are also many other criteria.

An important scholarship at NGU is the "Deutschlandstipendium". The application period is from July 15th to September 5th each year for the upcoming winter semester and summer semester.

Nürtingen:

More than 40,000 people live in the 7 districts of Nürtingen. The town is located in the district of Esslingen, just outside Stuttgart. You can reach Stuttgart or Tübingen within 30 minutes by train.

Geislingen:

Just over 28,000 people live in Geislingen an der Steige, which is in the district of Göppingen county. The nearest big cities are not that far away: Stuttgart can be reached by train in 40 minutes and Ulm within 30 minutes.

MS Office

Since May 2017 students of NGU can download the MS Office 365 Pro Plus software for 3.99 EUR per year, install it on 5 PCs, Macs and additionally 5 mobile devices and use it for 365 days. Parking

Campus Innenstadt: In Nürtingen you can park directly next to building CI10. As a member of the Hochschulbund (free of charge for students) you can also park your car at the parking lot behind Nürtingen train station.

Further parking facilities are available, for example, at Schlachthof (Mühlstraße) and at Wörthstraße.

Campus Braike: You will find free parking directly in front of building CB1. You can also use all public parking spaces around the campus.

Campus Geislingen: In Geislingen you will find parking facilities opposite the university beside the train station at the corner of Weilerstraße and Konrad-Adenauer-Straße. There are further parking possibilities at Parkstraße.

Print/Copy

Most printers are located in the PC rooms of the university, but some are also in the libraries.

StudiCard/Student-ID card

You have already received your StudiCard by mail. It is your most important identification document at NGU: student ID, proof of eligibility for public transportation, library card, door opener for some buildings, and your wallet for vending machines for drinks and snacks, for the washing machines in the dormitories, and for paying in the cafeteria at Campus Innenstadt.

What's what and who's who ...

Dean: Head Professor of a Faculty.

Faculty: A university's organizational unit, which comprises several degree programs. There are four of them at NGU.

IBIS: The Student Advisory Service at NGU. IBIS stands for "Individuelle Betreuung für ein individuelles Studium".

IO: The International Office (IO for short) takes care of all international matters at NGU. For example, the staff will support you if you would like to spend a semester abroad.

Chancellor: Head of the university administration. Currently the Chancellor of NGU is Claudia Uhrmann.

neo: Organization and communication platform for all students and lecturers - www.hfwu.de

Rector: Academic head of NGU. Currently this position is held by Prof. Dr. Andreas Frey.

VS: The student representative body – (Verfasste Studierendenschaft or VS for short) – is all of you! All students are automatically members of VS. VS is represented by the Student Council (StuRa), whose job it is to look after the students' interests.
