

Course and Exam Regulations

Addendum for Master Degree Course in
International Management
as of 12 July 2018

Legal basis:

On the basis of section 8 (6) in conjunction with section 30 (1) and section 32 (6) of the Law on Universities in Baden-Wuerttemberg (Landeshochschulgesetz - LHG) dated 01 April 2014 (Law Gazette (GBl.) 2014, p. 99 et.seqq.), the senate of the Hochschule für Wirtschaft und Umwelt Nürtingen-Geislingen agreed the following course and exam regulations for the master degree course in International Management on 05 July 2018.

1. Individual Regulations

1.1 Structure of the Course

The master degree course in International Management comprises 3 semesters. The entry requirements are governed by the statutes of admission.

- (1) The modules and module examinations required for successful completion of the master degree course are listed in the table in section 2.
- (2) The total amount of compulsory and elective modules required for successful completion of the course is defined in credits. To complete the master degree course 90 credits are required.
- (3) The master degree course consists of compulsory modules plus one elective module and, in certain cases, of additional modules. In section 2, the compulsory and elective modules are listed. In certain exceptional cases, students may select suitable modules from other master degree programs of HfWU Nuertingen-Geislingen University. This is only possible by submitting an application to the board of examiners which they need to approve. Students in the master degree course may choose additional modules from any of the modules offered at HfWU Nuertingen-Geislingen University if they wish.
- (4) Each student must choose an elective module. The deadlines for registration will be notified in advance.

1.2 Module Examinations

- (1) As a rule, module examinations must be taken as listed in the table in section 2. A module examination can only be retaken as a whole. It is not possible to retake only certain parts. Students are responsible for registering themselves for the examinations in FlexNow. The deadlines for registration will be notified in advance.
- (2) The topics for the "Preparatory Seminar Master Thesis" for the following semester will be posted on the bulletin board 4 weeks before the end of the current lecture period. Registration takes place one week after the topics have been posted on the bulletin board. The written assignment must be handed in no later than one week after the beginning of the lecture period.
- (3) If a module examination involves giving a presentation, the topics will be announced by the lecturer in charge during the first two weeks of the semester.
